Introduction



The HIVE is one of the Barren River Areas' leaders in continuum of learning and growth services for adults with intellectual and development disabilities (IDD) and their families, using research-informed programming. For individuals with IDD aging out of the public school system, The HIVE offers continued habilitative and educational services, bridging the decade long wait list for waiver services that stifles their personal success.

The needs are great and the stakes high to ensure adults with IDD receive continued programming and services to thrive in our communities. With nearly 20,000 young people living with IDD aging out of the public school system in the next decade, these adults are 5x more likely to experience mental distress that leads to a myriad of related physical health stressors and diseases. Over 60% of the families of these young adults do not have a plan for continued habilitative and educational services in a waiver system with a multi-year long wait for continued care. Far too many become isolated and in despair where potential goes untended.

At The HIVE, we prevent long term mental and physical health implications by tending to the whole person with cognitive, emotional, social, somatic, and relational programming.

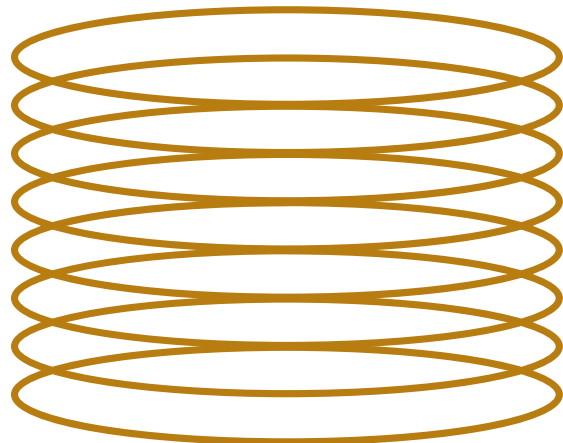
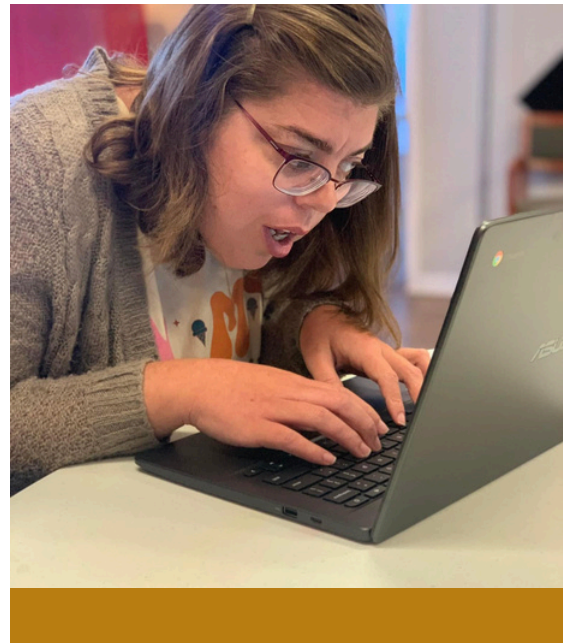
